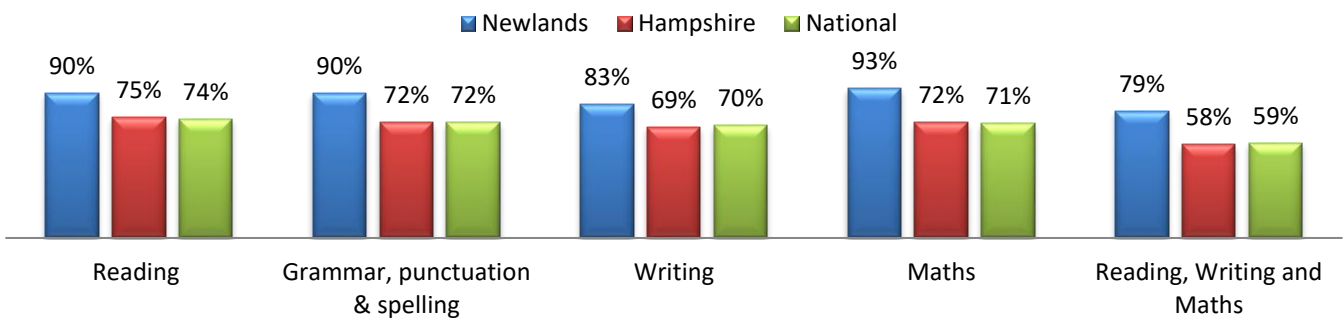




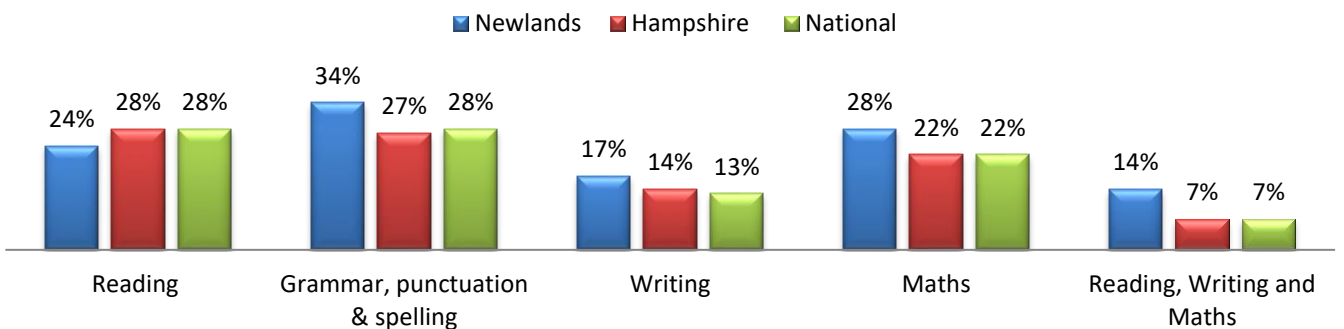
## 2022 KS2 Data Headlines

- Y6 assessment data for the expected standard is significantly (14-24%) that being reported nationally. With each child being worth 3% this means between 4-8 children have meet the expected standard that statistically speaking wouldn't necessarily have done so in another school. This is a huge vindication of the work put in by the staff in many years in putting together a broad, balanced and focused curriculum combined high quality Teaching and learning.
- With the exception of reading (which is 4%) below the Y6 assessment data for the greater depth is above (4-7%) that being reported nationally. With each child being worth 3% this means between 1-2 children have meet the greater depth standard that statistically speaking wouldn't necessarily have done so in another school.
