Competition Rules

The theme of the poster should focus on Yateley and surrounding area – children should think about what we can do to look after local places where we live, play and go to school. Here are a few theme suggestions to help: litter, energy, water, waste, transport, etc.

All posters should be drawn/painted on A4 paper. The completed competition entries must be submitted to the pupil's primary school by Friday 22nd March 2024, with this entry form.

Please do <u>not</u> put child's name on the front of the poster. Write pupil's first name, school and school year on a label on the back of the picture.

Posters will be collected from the school by a member of Yateley & District Lions on Monday 25th March.

Tudging

Stage 1: Entries will be judged and shortlisted to the best 6 per school (3 x KS1, 3 x KS2)

Stage 2: A winner will be chosen from each of the three KS1 finalists and three KS2 finalists from your school. The uniquely numbered posters will be displayed at the Yateley Lions May Fayre, Yateley Green on Monday, 6th May 2024. Entries will be judged by members of the public who will vote for their favourite poster, using a ballot box, at the Yateley & District Lions Club Information & Control Stall.

The Winners

The winner from each Key Stage will each receive a Certificate, a goodie bag and one of the books from the Wild Tribe Heroes series.

The prizes for the winning posters will be delivered/presented to the pupil at their school on Wednesday 5th June 2024.
